

# University of Taipei Chinese Certificate of Enrollment

- 1、The 10<sup>th</sup> Administration Meeting the 2014 Academic Year has approved that the enrollment stamping shall be canceled starting in the 2015 Academic Year. Existing students shall have “No Need for Enrollment” stickers on their Student ID Cards.
- 2、The student shall apply to reissue of Student ID Card if the card is lost.
- 3、According to the regulations of the Ministry of Education, the copies of the two sides of student ID cards are considered Chinese certificate of enrollment. If the student still needs stamps for enrollment, the student may apply by submitting the document attached with the copies of student ID card, **the certification of tuition and fees payment, and the original student ID card.**
- 4、Taiwan High Speed Rail recognized the University on its website as one that requires no stamps for certificate of enrollment on August 1, 2015.
- 5、The copies of the student ID card shall be attached as follows ( Front at the left; back at the right. **The copies shall be valid after being stamped by the Office of Academic Affairs. Invalid if altered :**
